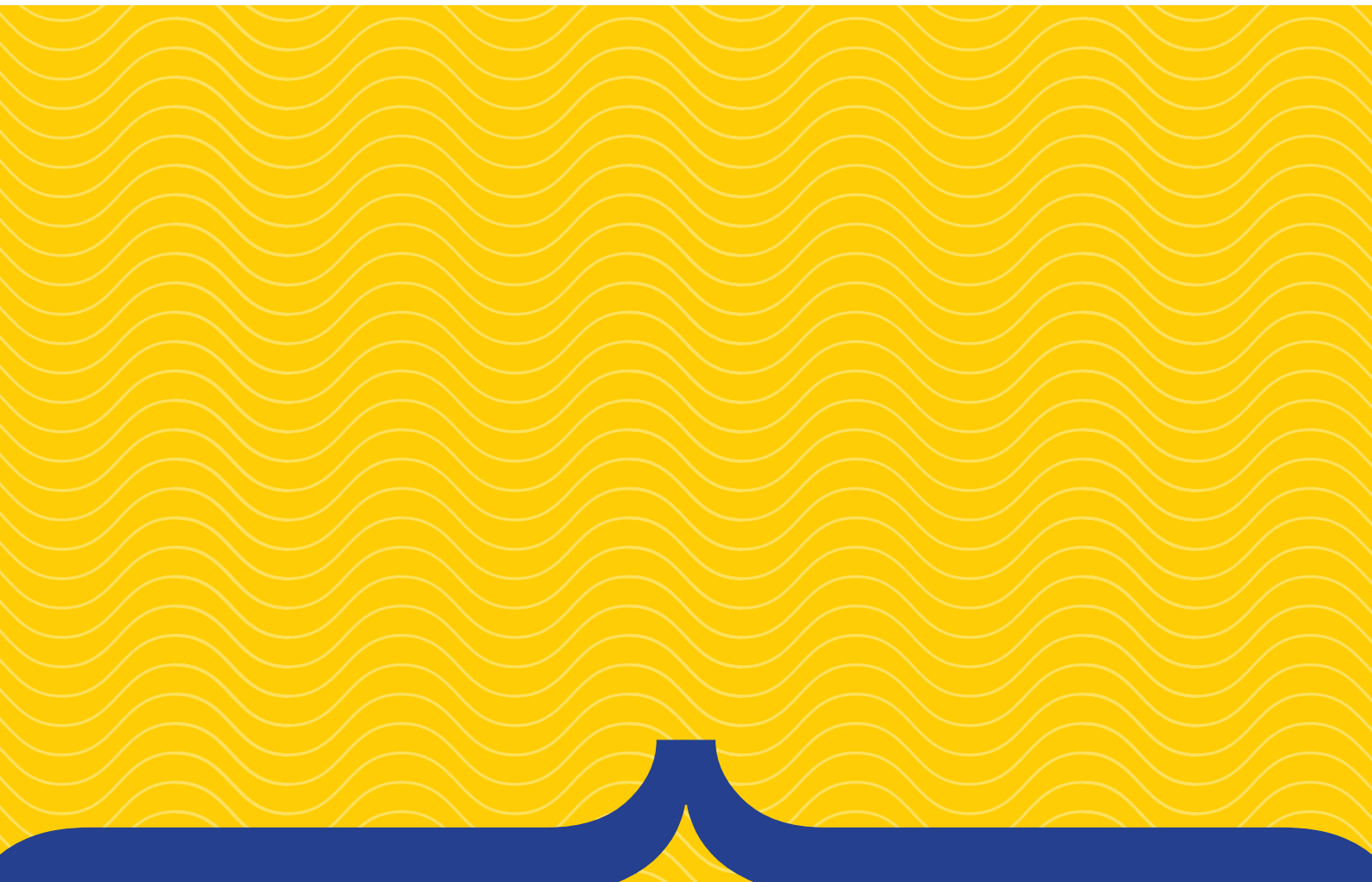

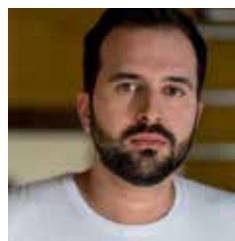

GROUPS TO BE VISITED

INVEST IN NORWAY is an investment promotion function within Innovation Norway, focusing on attracting and facilitating foreign direct investment to Norway. Invest in Norway was established in 2013 and is based on a network model, both utilizing the Innovation Norway network and the network of their partners, The Research Council of Norway and SIVA.

INNOVATION NORWAY is the Norwegian Government's most important instrument for innovation and development of Norwegian enterprises and industry. It supports companies in developing their competitive advantage and to enhance innovation.

THE MINISTRY OF TRADE, INDUSTRY AND FISHERIES is responsible for designing industrial and seafood policy with an eye to the future. This includes involvement in any policy area that affects value creation. The collective value creation nationwide is what determines prosperity and well-being in Norway.

THE NORWEGIAN VENTURE CAPITAL & PRIVATE EQUITY ASSOCIATION (NVCA) was established in February 2001 by the leading venture capital firms in Norway. NVCA is an independent, non-profit association supporting the interests of companies and persons who are active in the Norwegian venture capital and private equity industry.

NORDIC IMPACT is a company that invests in startups based around technology with a mission to have a positive impact on society. Nordic impact was started to gather the initiatives of Tharald Nustad around impact investments and social entrepreneurship. The main activity is invest-

ing in early stage impact tech startups, and projects that further impact investing and social entrepreneurship.

NORFUND is Norway's Development Finance Institution. Norfund's mandate is to support the building of sustainable businesses in poor countries and thereby contribute to economic and social development. Norfund is an active strategic minority investor – wholly owned and funded by the Norwegian Government. Norfund was founded in 1997 by the Norwegian Government. By year end 2015, Norfund's committed portfolio was USD 1,8 billion / NOK 15,1 billion and included more than 700 companies.

SKAGERAK MATURO is an early-stage technology investor. Since the late 1990s the team has been building successful ventures together with great entrepreneurs. Skagerak Maturo is the result of Skagerak Venture Capital and Maturo Kapital joining forces.

DNB is Norway's largest financial services group and one of the largest in the Nordic region in terms of market capitalisation. The Group offers a full range of financial services, including loans, savings, advisory services, insurance and pension products for retail and corporate customers.

OHOI - OSLO HOUSE OF INNOVATION is a 4000sqm building dedicated to innovation. This is an environment where investors can come with their portfolio of startups to shape an area where they can work closely with the people they believe in. It is an environment with a mix of innovation, competence and capital that will accelerate their shared value creation.

ALLIANCE VENTURE is a Norwegian venture capital firm investing in early stage technology companies. Total capital under management is 850 MNOK (about € 100 million).

ANGEL CHALLENGE is a workshop based program for angel investors and startups. For several evenings, twenty angel investors work together on investor analysis of a handful promising startups. The startups are competing for their trust and final investment of more than 1 million NOK.

KJELLER INNOVATION is an international organisation uniquely located at the heart of the Kjeller Research Park in Lillestrøm, Norway. We also have close ties to the research and education centre at Ås, south of Oslo, and a number of other research centres in Norway.

BUSINESS SWEDEN is an organisation jointly owned by the Government of Sweden and representatives from the Swedish business community, through the Swedish Foreign Trade Association. Its mission is to promote Swedish exports on behalf of the Swedish industry and government.

SWEDISH INCUBATORS & SCIENCE PARKS (SISP) is Sweden's national association for business incubators and science parks. SISP is a non-profit association with national coverage, its 65 members (organizing 43 business incubators and 33 science parks) having 5000 companies with more than 70 000 employees. Focus is to stimulate growth in knowledge-based companies.

STOCKHOLM BUSINESS ANGELS (STOAF) is an early stage investment company backing deep technology ventures crossing the chasm with almost 50

business angels who have pooled their time, international networks, experience and money together in order to help promising teams and ventures to grow to their global potential.

THE SWEDISH PRIVATE EQUITY AND VENTURE CAPITAL ASSOCIATION is the industry body and public policy advocate for the private equity and venture capital industry in Sweden. Today the Swedish private equity industry is one of the largest in Europe in relation to GDP. Private equity sponsored companies have close to 200 000 employees and their revenues are over 300 billion SEK, comparable to 8.4 % of Swedish GDP.

SYNCH is a business oriented law firm with innovation and technology at its heart. Synch believes that lawyers and legal services should always be in synch with the surrounding business environment.

SAAB VENTURES is the spin-in and spin-off engine of Saab AB. Saab has a long and strong track record in spin-offs ranging from cars to computers and 3D maps.

STARTUP HUB SUP46 was founded in 2013 to gather the startup community. Through the world-class ecosystem of investors, advisors and partners, members are offered a competitive advantage. Located in the heart of Stockholm, it is home to more than 60 startups and a natural meeting place for the startup community.

VINNOVA is Sweden's innovation agency. Its mission is to promote sustainable growth by improving the conditions for innovation, as well as funding needs-driven research.

WEBROCK VENTURES is a venture capital firm that invests in leading Scandinavian technology companies for successful roll out in Brazil.

INVENTURE is a leading early-stage venture capital company in the Nordics. Over the past 10 years they have been working with some of the best entrepreneurs in Finland, the Nordics and the Baltics, supporting innovative start-ups and high tech companies.

THE FINNISH VENTURE CAPITAL ASSOCIATION (FVCA) promotes the venture capital operating in Finland, as well as to protect the interests the private equity industry.

THE FINNISH BUSINESS ANGELS NETWORK (FIBAN) is a Finnish, non-profit association inspiring private startup investing. The network consists of over 500 approved investor members actively seeking new growth companies.

FINPRO helps Finnish SMEs go international, encourages foreign direct investment in Finland and promotes travel to Finland. Finpro is a public organization consisting of Export Finland, Visit Finland and Invest in Finland. Their almost 300 professionals work in 36 Trade Centers in 31 countries and 6 offices in Finland.

FINNISH INDUSTRY INVESTMENT

LTD is an investment arm of Ministry of Employment and the Economy, Finland specializing in direct and fund of fund investments. It does not invest in real estate and makes only minority investments in companies. Within direct investments, the firm makes private equity and venture capital investments in start-ups, early-mid-late venture stages, recapitalizations, growth, buyouts, turnaround, internationalization, mergers and acquisitions, spin-offs, emerging growth, and sectoral and corporate restructuring.

TEKES - THE FINNISH FUNDING AGENCY FOR TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATION,

a part of Finnish Ministry of Employment and the Economy, is the most important public funding agency for research funding in Finland. It was founded in 1983 through the president of Finland, Mauno Koivisto, who ratified the Act on the founding of Tekes.

ILMARINEN MUTUAL PENSION

INSURANCE COMPANY operates as an employment pension company in Finland. It provides employee's and self-employed person's earnings-related pension insurance.
